Whereas, the National Anti-Tuberculosis Society has striven through education, research, and medical service to reduce the misery and death toll annually caused by tuberculosis, and

Whereas, its motives are in keeping with highest principles of religious faith, and every year the Jews throughout the United States purchase the seals in support of its work, and

Whereas, this year the Society printed its seal with the inscription "Season's Greetings" instead of the former inscription, "Christmas Greetings," taking into consideration the frequent coincidence of Chanukah and the Christmas season, and desiring that the Jews make use of the seals on their holy days,

Therefore be it resolved, that the National Federation of Temple Sisterhoods appreciates this thoughtfulness and endorses the continued support of the work of the National Anti-Tuberculosis Society.
