

COMMENDATION OF THE PRESIDENT - 1940

Whereas, the President of the United States has seen fit to appoint representatives of the three great religious groups—the Catholic, the Protestant and the Jewish—in his most recent effort toward a peaceful mediation of the European War, therefore,

Be it resolved, that the Executive Board of the National Federation of Temple Sisterhoods, in annual meeting assembled, hereby commends his action which recognized the significance of religion as the dominant force in the establishment of a new world order that shall achieve permanent and just peace and universal brotherhood.
