PLIGHT OF DISPLACED PERSONS - 1946

We... reaffirm our Executive Board's concern (expressed December, 1945) with "the plight of displaced persons throughout the world, among them thousands upon thousands of our fellow Jews." On their behalf we again petition "President Truman to use his good offices to facilitate more adequate food, clothing and shelter" and particularly we urge for "their sake and the general welfare of mankind... the raising of immigration quotas throughout the world to insure a more free flow of humanity to countries of choice."

Once again, as did the NFTS Board at its last session, we "earnestly plead with the conscience of mankind to the end that there shall be opened the gates of Palestine to those Jews who desire to settle there."
