

HOUSING - 1947

Whereas, the Executive Board of the National Federation of Temple Sisterhoods, in annual session assembled, recognizes that the housing situation in this country has been inadequate for many years and has become increasingly acute since the war and that the country owes a special duty to the veterans who have experienced the greatest dislocation in their lives due to this critical shortage, and since the strength of any free people depends upon the general welfare of its citizens; and

Whereas, there have been introduced in both Houses of Congress bills to set up a national housing policy for the nation,

Therefore, be it resolved, that the Executive Board of the National Federation of Temple Sisterhoods urge immediate passage of the Ellender-Taft-Wagner Bill S. 866 and its equivalent in the House of Representatives.
