Praise for Bipartisan Commitment to Israel

Rabbi Saperstein commented on the bipartisan support for Israel's security, exhibited first in President Obama's signing of the U.S.-Israel Enhanced Cooperation Act, and then in Governor Romney's speech on Sunday in Jerusalem. He urged Congress to adopt this rare, bipartisan model in seeking solutions for our nation's greatest challenges.
