

NEAR EAST RELIEF - 1923

Whereas, the whole world stands appalled at the desperate plight of the non-Moslem minorities in the Near East; and

Whereas, Near East Relief is now caring for 110,000 orphan children and at least as many more have not yet been reached; and

Whereas, Near East Relief is doing its utmost to aid in removing and caring for the refugees from Smyrna and Thrace,

Be it resolved, that the National Federation of Temple Sisterhoods does hereby endorse the work of Near East Relief in its efforts to alleviate and remove these desperate conditions, and

Be it Further resolved, that we express to the President of the United States, the Secretary of State and the Foreign Relations Committee in both the Senate and the House, the urgent hope that some way may be found to secure the protection of the non-Moslem women and children of the Near East.
