

PROTEST AGAINST MILITARISM IN PRESS AND FILM - 1925

Resolved, that the Cooperation Section of the National Federation of Temple Sisterhoods meeting in Biennial Session January 1925, send to the Quinquennial of the International Council of Women, to be held in Washington in May 1925, a protest against militaristic propaganda as given out by the Press, and a request to Film News producers to show more Peace News items of interest, rather than news of inventions of implements of war, including battleships. And that we also express our disapproval of National Defense Day because of its tendency to glorify war to the younger generation.
