

UNITED NATIONS - 1953

We believe that all people are equal and united to one another in the brotherhood of man and the fatherhood of God; and that the best interests of the world may be obtained through mutual deliberation and consideration; that more than two-thirds of the world's people live in underdeveloped countries where there is a low standard; and that only through the elimination of want and starvation may all men become equal.

Therefore, be it resolved, that the National Federation of Temple Sisterhoods in convention assembled, urge upon itself, its affiliated units and their members further support of the United Nations and study of its specialized agencies, in order that it may continue in the "brotherhood of man and the fatherhood of God,"

And be it further resolved, that the National Federation of Temple Sisterhoods in Biennial Assembly hopes the United Nations will continue its projects of technical assistance to underdeveloped areas of the world and that the United States will continue to make available to the UN its technical knowledge and teams of experts.
