

ARMS TO THE MIDDLE EAST - 1955

An arms race anywhere in the world poses a grave danger to its peace. We are, therefore, greatly disturbed by the sending by the United States Government of gifts of arms to the Arab nations without receiving any guarantees that these arms will be used for the defense of the free world.

Therefore, be it resolved, that we urge such shipments be halted until adequate guarantees are given that such arms are to be used only for the defense of the area.
